
Let's Basketball!

Who Invented Basketball?




James Naismith!




Who was "Phog Allen?"



Allen Fieldhouse is where the University of Kansas basketball team plays their home games! It was built in 1952, and it was named after "Phog" Allen. Have you ever been to a K.U. basketball game?

Wilt Chamberlain

Chamberlain played for the University of Kansas Basketball team from 1956-1958. He then played in the NBA and set many different records.

Clyde Lovellette

Lovellette played for the University of Kansas from 1949-1952. He later played in the Olympics and was a 4-time NBA All-star.





Paul Pierce

Pierce played for the University of Kansas from 1995-1998. He played for the Boston Celtics. Shaquille O'Neal nicknamed him "The Truth."

In order to complete this packet, please complete the following craft: A hand-held basketball hoop! In order to do this, please follow the instructions below:

- 1. Open your craft packet! Find the string and the ping pong ball.
- 2. Glue or tape the string onto the top of the ping pong ball.
- 3. Next, locate the craft stick.
- 4. Glue or tape the other end of the string onto one side of the craft stick.
- 5. Next, locate the cup. Glue the bottom of the cup on the same end of the craft stick over the string.
- 6. Wait for the glue to dry.
- 7. Try to toss the ball into the cup!
